The Grace Ross Shanley Scholarship Fund is named in honor of the founder of the Center for Contemporary Printmaking. Grace was a firm believer both in the importance of community and the need for ongoing education about printmaking. The mission of this program is to further the growth of artists and foster the next generation of printmakers.

Over the course of a single academic year, with the opportunity to continue on for a second year, students will select, analyze and apply the expressive potential of printmaking media, techniques and processes. In the program, they will create a body of original work that exhibits their ability to use elements of art such as of line, shape, value, texture, space and perspective. Students will also learn to practice safe and responsible use of art media, equipment and studio space. They will also develop critical visual and oral skills through individual and group critiques.

The culmination of their efforts will be the creation of a portfolio of their work that displays the use of the above skills, techniques and concepts. This portfolio of work can be used for applying to art schools if desired. The Grace Ross Shanley Fellowships is open to incoming 11th graders with an option for a second year for independent study where the student will create a complete body of work with a small exhibition at the end of year.

Expectations:

- Students are expected to show up every week for class
- Students should participate in all CCP activities made available to them
- Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from CCP.

Eligibility:

- Area students entering their Junior year of high school in September.

All material expenses are covered by CCP.
