ABOUT THE CENTER FOR CONTEMPORARY PRINTMAKING

The Center for Contemporary Printmaking was founded as a nonprofit 501(c)(3) in 1995 by Grace and William Shanley and a group of like-minded artists and community leaders. From its beginning, CCP's mission has been to support, preserve, and advance the art of original prints. The Center is dedicated to increasing awareness, knowledge, and appreciation for prints and the process of printmaking through exhibitions, publications, educational programs, and artist workshops.

CCP is located in the historic stone carriage house of the Lockwood-Mathews Mansion in Norwalk, CT. This state-of-the-art printmaking facility is equipped with five intaglio presses, one lithographic press, a Vandercook press, an hydraulic press, an acid room, silkscreen facilities, a paper mill, a metal shear, an exposure table for photo-plate making, and a digital studio for printmaking projects. The Grace Ross Shanley Gallery hosts numerous exhibitions throughout the year.

The Helen Frankenthaler Printmaking Cottage is the home of the Artist-in-Residence Program and is equipped with two intaglio presses, a small kitchen and living accommodations for both printmaking and overnight guests.
